Privacy Policy

At Vision 2 Market we respect and protect the privacy of our customers and those who visit our website. The following Privacy Statement provides details about how your personal information is collected and used. This privacy statement applies to Vision 2 Market programs and services featured on avision2market.com.

Information Collection and Use

Vision 2 Market owns the information collected on avision2market.com. We pledge not sell, share, or rent this information to third parties beyond what is written in this statement. Vision 2 Market collects information from our users in various sections of our website.

Our website offers visitors an opportunity to submit their contact information via a form on our website in an effort to seek Vision 2 Market services. Visitors provide contact information such as name and email address. We use this contact information to send users information about Vision 2 Market and its programs and services if requested or necessary. A user may opt-out of receiving future mailings at any time. Users can also comment on Vision 2 Market blog posts using their email address. We do not share, sell or rent user email addresses.

Sharing and Usage

We will never share, sell, or rent your personal information with third parties for their promotional use. Occasionally, we may enter into contracts with third parties so that they can assist us in servicing you by providing customer services in collaboration with Vision 2 Market. Vision 2 Market prohibits third party vendors from using any of your personal information for their own purposes, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of the information we provide to them. We may also disclose information to partners who introduced you to Vision 2 Market services in order to ensure they are properly compensated for their efforts. Lastly, we may disclose or report personal information in limited cases where we believe in good faith that disclosure is obligatory under the law. Use of Web Technologies

We use a technology called Cookies on our website. Cookies are pieces of information stored in your browser when you visit our site. Cookies allow us to track overall site usage and determine a user's particular area of preference, enabling us to make your visit to our website easier by recognizing you when you return and helping to provide you with a personalized experience.

Usage of a cookie cannot be linked to any personally identifiable information while you are visiting on our site. If you choose to disable cookies you can still use our site but you may not have access to some areas within our website.

We also record activity on our website via log files stored on our web servers. We collect information such as IP address, browser type and version, and pages you view. We record how you got to our site and any links you click on to leave our site. Once you leave our site, we do not track you. We use your website history to assist us in offering you a

better web experience predicated on assisting you with technical support, diagnosing problems with our server, administering our website and to tailor our programs and service offerings to you.

Security

We take precautions necessary to safeguard the confidentiality and security of your personal information by using industry-recognized security safeguards such as firewalls, coupled with carefully developed security procedures/systems available through our hosting company to protect your information from loss, misuse or unauthorized modification.
